The purpose of the meeting is to receive public comments from the community about state sovereign land in the City of Burlingame. The land, approximately 8.8 acres fronting San Francisco Bay, is state-owned. Its use must be consistent with the Public Trust Doctrine and align with the City of Burlingame's land use policies. State Lands Commission staff is preparing a Public Trust Needs Assessment for the area and is seeking public input for its use. Staff will reflect this input in the Public Trust Needs Assessment that it will present to the Commission at a future Commission meeting. A map of the area is attached.
