Project Title: PG&E Line 406/407 Natural Gas Pipeline Project

Proponent: Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E)

Project Location: The proposed pipeline would be approximately 40 miles long spanning four counties: Sutter, Sacramento, Yolo, and Placer.


Project Description: PG&E is proposing to construct a 30-inch diameter natural gas pipeline (Lines 406 and 407) and a new distribution feeder main from Esparto in Yolo county east, to a location near Roseville, in Placer county. The project would also include the construction of six above-ground facilities.

This is to advise that the Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on November 16, 2009, and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project.


- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.



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Project Location including Alternative Options I and L (see attached)

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
