Pursuant to Government Code 11346.4, the California State Lands Commission, Marine Facilities Division (Commission) is proposing regulatory amendments to Title 24, Part 2, Chapter 31F – Marine Terminals, of the California Building Code 2016. This will amend the 2013 California Building Code.

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, the Commission is required to hold a minimum 45-day period for receiving comments and testimony from interested parties and the public. These comments must be submitted to the Commission prior to closing of the comment period, which is 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 13, 2015. 
