
CHAPTER 484

An act to add Section 3.5 to Chapter 231 of the Statutes of 1935, relating to resources.

[Approved by Governor July 12, 1980. Filed with
Secretary of State July 13, 1980.]

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3.5 is added to Chapter 231 of the Statutes of 1935, to read:

Sec. 3.5. The Legislature finds and declares that under existing law and this statute, that portion of the tidelands and submerged lands granted to the City of Pacific Grove hereinafter described may be leased for purposes of a nonprofit aquarium for the benefit, education and enjoyment of the public and for the conduct of scientific research in the field of marine biology.

The portion of the tidelands and submerged lands is described as

follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southeasterly corporate limit line of the City of Pacific Grove produced and the mean high tide of the bay of Monterey; thence N 58°58'E to the point in the bay of Monterey where the depth of water in said bay is 60 feet measured from the level of mean low tide; thence northwesterly 500 feet along the line of said bay which line is a constant depth of 60 feet measured from the level of mean low tide; thence S 58°58'W to the mean high tide of the bay of Monterey; thence southeasterly along said mean high tide to point of beginning.
