

CHAPTER 893.

*An act respecting the tidelands and submerged lands embraced
in Chapter 49, Statutes of 1923, and Chapter 293, Statutes*

of 1931, located in San Diego Bay, county of San Diego, State of California.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The State Lands Commission is hereby authorized to survey, redescribe, and fix the boundaries of and between the tidelands and submerged lands embraced and described in Chapter 49, Statutes of 1923 and Chapter 293, Statutes of 1931, provided no additional tidelands or submerged lands not embraced in said statutes or either thereof are included. Authority to

SEC. 2. After such surveys, and subject to the approval of the State Lands Commission, the City of Coronado, acting through its Mayor upon authorization by resolution duly promulgated by the city council, may convey any portion of the tidelands and submerged lands embraced in Chapter 49, Statutes 1923, to the State of California or to the United States of America, but any land so conveyed to the United States of America shall become a part of the tidelands and submerged lands described in Chapter 293, Statutes of 1931, and be subject to all of the provisions of said statute. SEC. 3. After such surveys, and subject to the approval of the State Lands Commission, the United States of America, acting through its duly authorized agency or officers may convey any portion of the lands embraced in Chapter 293, Statutes 1931, to the State of California or the City of Coronado, but any tideland or submerged land conveyed to the City of Coronado shall become a part of the tidelands and submerged lands embraced in Chapter 49, Statutes of 1923, and be subject to all of the provisions of said statute.
