**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER AN ADDENDUM
TO A NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

An Addendum to a Negative Declaration (ND) has been prepared by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC or Commission), as a Responsible Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.), in response to an application submitted by Cove Britton of Matson Britton Architects, acting as an agent for Sharon and Phil Lebherz, for the Lebherz Seawall Repair (Project). Construction of the original seawall was conducted under a ND adopted in 1986 by the city of Capitola as CEQA lead agency, and included the fill of a sea cave with concrete to prevent further undermining of the coastal bluff. The Addendum is in compliance with the requirements of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.).

Project Title: Lebherz Seawall Repair

Project Location: 110 Grove Lane, city of Capitola, Santa Cruz County, California

Project Description: The Project would include repair of a portion of an existing seawall on State sovereign land.
