Title: San Francisco Bay and Delta Sand Mining Project.

Proponent: California State Lands Commission.

Location: San Francisco, Marin, Contra Costa, Sacramento, and San Joaquin Counties.

Description: The State Lands Commission action is a 10-year General Lease through December 31, 2022. Hanson Marine Operations (Hanson) proposed new 10-year mineral extraction leases to enable the continuation of dredge mining of construction-grade sand from certain delineated areas of Central San Francisco Bay (Central Bay), Suisun Bay (the easternmost of the four main basins that comprise San Francisco Bay), and the western Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta area (Delta).

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on October 19, 2012, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared and certified pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
 A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
 A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
 A substitute document prepared under a certified state regulatory program was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251).
 An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) of Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was prepared by a federal agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and is being used in the place of an EIR, MND, or negative declaration pursuant to the provisions of CEQA (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251).
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
