1. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carriec, the minutes of the meeting of the State Iands Commission held in Sacramento on diarch 21, 1949, yere appruved and confirmed as submitteci.
2. (Legislation - W.0. 3i4) The Comnission was informed with respect to the following bills:
(a) S.B. 88 - Senator 7atson - supplements the Harbors and Navigation Code - Legislative Counsel suggests that the bill be amended to avoid the conflict of the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving the support of an amendment of S.B. 88 to the offect that the provisions of S.B. 88 do not repeal jurisdictional authority of the Public Resources Code as to use of State tide and submerged Iands.
(b) 5.3842 - The Commission was informed that the Shoreline Planning Association desired the Commission to sponsor S. B. 84?, Senator 0'Gara. The purpose of this bill was to give the State lands Cemmission authority to force removal of any structures on granted or ungranted tidelands.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted directing that Senator OMara and the Shoreline Planning Association be informed that the Comission nas unvilling to sponsor this bill but that no opposition would be made to it.
(c) Torrens Title Buaget Itemil48,

Ljeutenant Governor Goodwin J. Knight raised the question of the necessity of the $\$ 10,000$ budget item in Comaission's budget with respect to an investigation on the Torrens Title situation. The staff explained that the Torrens Ticle gusrantee.funduas a deficit.

Upon mation duly made and unanimously carried, a resclution was adopted confinting that the $\$ 10,000$ item placed in the budget should continue to be requested.
