3. (APPLICATION FOR LEASE, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, SAN FRANCISCO, ADOLPH G. SUTRO - W.O. 1261, P.R.C. 742.2.) Mr. Adolph G. Sutro has applied for a lease of approximately one acre of tide and submerged lands adjacent to Sutro () Baths at Pt. Lobos in the City and County of San Francisco. The purpose of the lease is the construction of a seawall and fill to be used as a playground in connection with the baths and ice rink. Mr. Walter S.
