MINUTE ITEM

12. (APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, VENTURA COUNTY, SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY - W. O. 2942, P.R.C. 2180.1.)

The Commission was informed that the Southern California Edison Company, on June 11, 1958, applied for an easement extending approximately 4,325 feet into the Pacific Ocean from the ordinary high water mark at the location of the Mandalay Steam Station, approximately one-half mile north of West Fifth Street, in the County of Ventura. The proposed use is the construction, maintenance, and operation of a marine pipe line and appurtenances for the purpose of conveying petroleum products necessary for the plant operation. An easement for a term of 49 years has been requested, under the same agreement conditions authorized by the Commission on August 8, 1957 (Minute Item 12, pages 3386-88), for Easement P.R.C. 1980.1, W. O. 2254, issued to Southern California Edison Company for the construction, maintenance, and use of cooling water intake and discharge pipe lines in connection with a steam plant at Huntington Beach, Orange County.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY AN EASEMENT EXTENDING APPROXIMATELY 4,325 FEET INTO THE PACIFIC OCEAN FROM THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ADJOINING THE SITE OF THE MANDALAY STEAM STATION, APPROXIMATELY ONE-HALF MILE NORTH OF WEST FIFTH STREET, COUNTY OF VENTURA, FOR A TERM OF 49 YEARS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF A MARINE PIPE LINE AND APPURTENANCES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVEYING PETROLEUM PRODUCTS. THE ANNUAL RENTAL IS TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ESTABLISHED POLICIES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENTS, AND THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE EASEMENT AGREEMENT ARE TO BE IN THE FORM AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION ON AUGUST 8, 1957, FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT P.R.C. 1980.1.
