APPLICARION FOR SUBMARINE PIPE LINE EASEMENT OVER IIDE AND SUBMERGED IANDS In the santa barbaira channel, santa barbara couniy, texaco inc. - W.0. 4029.

An application has been received from Texaco Inc, fus a short-term rightof way 30 feet in width and 10,338 feet in length over tide and submerged lands of the Pacific Ocean for the purpose of installing and maintaining temporary pipe lines, power lines, and related facilities to serve State 0 il and Gas Lease P.R.C. 2725.1, dated May 4, 1961. The lines would be laid in a bundle upon the ocean floor from P.R.C. 2725.1 - Well No. 1, to Texaco Platform Helen - Lease P.R.C. 2206.1 (see Exhibit "A"). The easement site roughly parallels the shoreline ak out a mile and a half offshore and crosses over the area included in Oil and Gas Leaje P.R.C. 2726.1, issued to Richfield Oil Corporation. Paragrarh 7 of the lease recites that "The State expressly reserves the right to allow, and to continue to allow if and where presently existing, upon suci terms as the State may determine, joint or several use of such easements or rights of way, including easements upon, through, or in the leased lands as may be necessary or appropriate for the workirg of any State lands." Richfield Oil Corpolition has advised that it has no objection to the location of the pipe line across its lease as shown in Exhibit "A". The rental of the 7.12 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands would be at the established mirimum of $\$ 100$ for the one-year term, without option for renewal.

The expense deposit and statutory filing fee have been paid. No performance bond is required as the installation would not adversely affect public use of the site for navigaijion and fishing.
