MINUTE ITEM

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34. WITHDRAWAL OF VACANT SCHOOL LAND IN LAKE COUNTY FOR DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - S.W.O. 7151.

After consideration of Calendar Item 9 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE WITHDRAWAL FROM PUBLIC SALE OF THE W_2^1 OF SE_4^1 OF SECTION 19, SW_4^1 OF NW_4^1 AND NW_4^1 OF SW_4^1 OF SECTION 27, N_2^1 OF S_2^1 OF SECTION 28, E_2^1 OF NW_4^1 , W_2^1 OF NE_4^1 AND NE_4^1 OF NE_4^1 OF SECTION 29 AND N_2^1 OF NE_4^1 OF SECTION 30, ALL IN T. 13 N., R. 5 W.; THE NW_4^1 OF SW_4^1 OF SECTION 12, NE_4^1 OF NW_4^1 OF SECTION 15, SE_4^1 OF NE_4^1 OF SECTION 20. LOT 1 OF SECTION 24, AND NE_4^1 OF NW_4^1 OF SECTION 29, ALL IN T. 13 N., R. 6 W., M.D.M., CONTAINING A TOTAL OF 789.37 ACRES IN LAKE COUNTY, IS EXTENDED TO DECEMBER 31, 1963. FURTHER, IN THE EVENT THE LANDS EMBRACED IN CANCELLED APPLICATION 5202, SACRAMENTO LAND DISTRICT, S.W.O. 6260, AND APPLICATION 5461, SACRAMENTO LAND DISTRICT, S.W.O. 7448, ARE RESTORED TO ENTRY, THE APPLICANTS, FRANCES CAIN AND JAMES R. CORBETT, RESPECTIVELY, ARE TO BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY IN THE EVENT THEY ARE DESIROUS OF FILING APPLICA-TIONS THEREON.

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CALENDAR ITEM

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WITHDRAWAL OF VACANT SCHOOL LAND IN LAKE COUNTY FOR DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - S.W.O. 7151.

In cooperation with the Department (former Division) of Water Resources and the County of Yolo, the State Lands Commission adopted a resolution at its meeting of July 2, 1956, withdrawing the following-described lands from sale until December 31, 1957:

 $W_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $SE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 19, $SW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $NW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ and $NW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $SW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 27, N $_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ of $S_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ of Section 28, $E_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ of $NW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$, $W_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ of $NE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ and $NE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $NE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 29 and $N_{\overline{2}}^{1}$ of $NE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 30, T. 13 N., R. 5 W., and $NW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $SW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 12, $NE_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of $NW_{\overline{4}}^{1}$ of Section 15 and Lot 1 of Section 24, T. 13 N., R. 6 W., M.D.M., containing a total of 709.37 acres in Lake County.

The purpose of this withdrawal was to permit an investigation of the lands for the proposed construction of a dam in Wilson Valley to conserve the waters of Cache Creek.

Subsequent to this action, and based on further requests by the Department of Water Resources, the withdrawal was extended until December 31, 1961. These subsequent actions included the withdrawal until December 31, 1961, of an additional parcel of 40 acres described as the NE_{4}^{1} of NW_{4}^{1} of Section 29, T. 13 N., R. 5 W., M.D.M., under application at that time by Frances Cain, and a 40-acre parcel described as the SE_{4}^{1} of NE_{4}^{1} of Section 20, T. 13 N., R. 6 W., M.D.M., under application at that time by James R. Corbett. The actions relating to these 40-acre parcels accorded Frances Cain and James R. Corbett the right of filing the first application in the event the lands were restored to entry.

A letter dated August 16, 1961, from Alfred R. Golze, Chief Engineer of the Department of Water Resources, requests an extension of the aforesaid withdrawal to December 31, 1963. The letter states that the Legislature during its 1961 session referred the Wilson Valley Project to an interim committee for study, and that the project will be considered by the Legislature during the 1963 session. The extension has therefore been requested to provide time for action by the Legislature and by local interests.
