

MINUTE ITEM

4. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TERM, DREDGING PERMIT P.R.C. 2659.1,
ARCHIBALD, SAN MATEO COUNTY - W.O. 4234.

After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly
and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted.

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXTEND THE TERM OF DREDGING PERMIT
P.R.C. 2659.1, COVERING APPROXIMATELY 1.58 ACRES OF LAND IN THE BED OF
REDWOOD CREEK NEAR THE MOUTH OF STEINBERGER SLOUGH AS DESCRIBED BELOW,
FROM DECEMBER 31, 1961, TO DECEMBER 31, 1963, INCLUSIVE; ALL OTHER TERMS
AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED.

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTHEASTERN CORNER OF THE J. O.
ARCHIBALD PROPERTY; THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY 600 FEET ALONG THE
EXISTING LEVEE; THENCE DUE EAST 115 FEET; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY
600 FEET PARALLEL TO SAID LEVEE; THENCE DUE WEST 115 FEET TO THE
POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 1.58 ACRES MORE OR LESS, IN SAN
MATEO COUNTY.

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TERM, DREDGING PERMIT P.R.C. 2659.1, J. O. ARCHIBALD, SAN MATEO COUNTY - W.O. 4234.

On October 27, 1960 (Minute Item 2, pages 6359-60), the Commission authorized the Executive Officer to issue to J. O. Archibald Dredging Permit P.R.C. 2659.1, covering approximately 1.58 acres of land in the bed of Redwood Creek near the mouth of Steinberger Slough, San Mateo County.

The permit authorized the extraction of 15,000 cubic yards of material at a royalty of one cent per cubic yard. The purpose of the dredging operation was to provide an entrance channel to a small-craft marina. The permit expired on December 31, 1961.

The permittee has requested an additional period of time within which to complete this project. The term of the Department of the Army permit issued by the U. S. Corps of Engineers will expire on December 31, 1963.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHCRIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXTEND THE TERM OF DREDGING PERMIT P.R.C. 2659.1, COVERING APPROXIMATELY 1.58 ACRES OF LAND IN THE BED OF REDWOOD CREEK NEAR THE MOUTH OF STEINBERGER SLOUGH AS DESCRIBED BELOW, FROM DECEMBER 31, 1961, TO DECEMBER 31, 1963, INCLUSIVE; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED.

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTHEASTERN CORNER OF THE J. O. ARCHIBALD PROPERTY; THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY 600 FEET ALONG THE EXISTING LEVEE; THENCE DUE EAST 115 FEET; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY 600 FEET PARALLEL TO SAID LEVEE; THENCE DUE WEST 115 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 1.58 ACRES MORE OR LESS, IN SAN MATEO COUNTY.
