11. REQUEST FOR PARTIAL ASSIGNMENT, P.R.C. 2205.1; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, EDWIN W. PAULEY, ET AL.; SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 4183.

After consideration of Calendar Item 14 attached, and upon motion duly male and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT TO THE SHELL OIL COMPANY OF THE INTEREST OF PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, EDWIN W. PAULEY, AND OTHER JOINT LESSEES IN STATE OIL AND GAS LEAS_ P.K.C. 2205.1, COVERING THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED SUBMERGED LANDS IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY:

THAT AREA O' SUBMERGED LANDS BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY CALLFORNIA COORDINATE SYSTEM, ZONE 5, GRID LINE HAVING AN X VALUE OF 1,392.440; ON THE EAST BY A GRID LINE HAVING AN X VALUE OF 1,403,000; ON THE SEAWARD (SOUTHERLY) BOUNDARY BY A LINE PARALLL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN AND SEAWARD THEREFROM 3 STATUTE MILES; ON THE LANDWARD (NORTHERLY) BOUNDARY BY A STRAIGHT LINE DRAWN FROM A POINT ON SAID WESTERLY BOUNDARY 7,500 FEET NORTHERLY OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LEASE, TO A POINT ON SAID LASTERLY BOUNDARY 7,500 FEET NORTHERLY OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LEASE.

THE ASSIGNEE IS TO BE HOUND BY THE TERMS OF THE LEASE TO THE SAME EXTENT AS THE ORIGINAL LESSERS.

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REQUEST FOR PARTIAL ASSIGNMENT, P.R.C. 2205.1; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, EDWIN W. PAULEY, ET AL.; SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 4183.

On July 25, 1958, Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 2205.1 was issued to Phillips Petroleum Company, Edwin W. Pauley, et al., joint bidders, pursuant to competitive public bidding in accordance with Division 6 of the Public Resources Code. (See Exhibit "B" attached which lists all bidders.)

An application has been received from Phillips Petroleum Company, operator, for approval of the partial assignment of the interest in the lease of Phillips Petroleum Company, Edwin W. Pauley, et al., to Shell Oil Company.

Section 4 of the lease provides for the assignment of interest in the lease, with the approval of the State, to a corporation which, at the time of the proposed assignment, possesses the qualifications required by the Public Resources Code. The Shell Oil Company has submitted evidence showing that it possesses the qualifications necessary to satisfy the code requirements.

The bord requirements of the lease have been fulfilled by the assignee. The four of assignment has been executed by Phillips Petroleum Company, Edwin W. Fauley, and other joint lessees, assignors, and by Shell Oil Company as assignee.

The \$5 statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.
