20. STATUS OF MAJOR LITIGATION - W.O.s 3019, 2224, 2716 AND 3662.

Item 2 of Informative Calendar Item 19 attached, the Alamitos Bay quitclaim litigation, was supplemented by the Executive Officer as follows:

The Supreme Court, on April 18, 1962 (subsequent to the preparation of this agenda item) denied the petition for hearing by the City of Long Beach, with the practical effect that the development of a segment of one of the richest oil pools of the State will be under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission. This area, unlike the remainder of the Long Beach tidelands, is not impressed with any obligation to share oil revenues with the City of Long Beach.

The Flaintiff and the major Defendants, including the State of California and the City of Long Beach, filed Opening Briefs on Legal Issues on April 2, 1962. Closing Briefs are now due on or before June 1, 1962. A pretrial conference on limited issues has been set commencing on October 2, 1962.
