An application has been received from the Hidden Splendor Mining Company, a Delaware corporation, for a permit to prospect for all minerals, other than oil and gas, on approximately 618 acres of vacant State school land, comprising all of Section 16, T. 18 S., R. 12 E., M.D.B.& M., San Benito County.

Field reconnaissance and record review by the staff have shown that the area for which the application has been made cannot be classified at this time as known to contain commercially valuable mineral deposits.

The application was referred to the office of the Attorney General, as required under Section 6890 of the Public Resources Code, which office has advised that the application complies with the applicable laws and the rules and regulations of the State Lands Commission.

The \$5 statutory filing fee has been paid, and the permit fee of \$618 bas been deposited by the applicant.
