APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL OPERATIONS, P.R.C. 2873.1, POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, TO THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC.

Pursuant to an application by Standard Oil Company of California, Kestern Operations, Inc., for a permit to conduct geophysical operations, where such operations are authorized, on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between a line drawn due West from Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, and the northern boundary of the State of California (excluding San Francisco Bay and other inland waters draining therein), the State Lands Commission, on March 29, 1962, authorized the Executive Officer to issue a permit conforming to all operating requirements established by the Commission in the area applied for, with the exception of the Merin Gounty offshore area. The exception was made pursuant to a telegram opposing the application, received on March 28, 1962, from the Board of Supervisors of Marin County.

Geophysical Permit P.R.C. 2873.1, covering the tide and submerged lands applied for excepting the Marin County offshore area, has been issued.

The Board of Supervisors of Marin County now has submitted a written withdrawal of any opposition to the granting of the ambject permit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE OCCURSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO INCLUDE THE MARIN COUNTY OFFICER AREA IN GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PLRMIT P.R.C. 2873.1, ISSUED TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, MESTERN OPERATIONS, INC.
