This case also seeks multimillion dollar damages for alleged injury to federal installations, principally the Long Beach Naval Shipyard.)

The State of California, in conjunction with the City of Long Beach, filed its Reply Brief in the United States District Court on June 29, 1962. Further proceedings are expected before the District Court the first week in October, 1962.
