AGREEMENT AND RATIFICATION, COMPENSATORY ROYALTY AGREEMENT P.R.C. 2834.1, McMULLIN RANCH AREA, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; GREAT BASINS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W.O. 4426.

Compensatory Royalty Agreement P.R.C. 2834.1 was issued to Great Basins Petroleum Company on November 23, 1961, and runs coextensively with Great Basins, et al., oil and gas leases affecting certain lands known as the McMullin Ranch Area, San Joaquin County, California. This agreement as entered into pursuant to Section 6815 of the Public Resources Code, to assure compensation to the State for drainage of gas from State lands by wells drilled upon private lands within the McMullin Ranch Area in the bed of a portion of the San Joaquin River and certain swamp and overflowed lands in Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 34, 35 and 36, T. 2 S., R. 6 E., M.D.B.& M., San Joaquin County.

Compensatory Royalty Agreement P.R.C. 2834.1 defines "Outside Lands" as those lands within said McMullin Ranch Area abutting State lands, with respect to which Lessee does not own all of the oil and gas operating rights (see Exhibit "A"). Paragraph 3 of the Compensatory Royalty Agreement provides among other things that within one hundred eighty days from the effective date of the Agreement, the Lessee is to consummate agreements with the owners of oil-and-gas operating-rights in said "Outside Lands", under which said owners, with the consent of the State, will assume the obligations of this agreement with respect to production of gas from wells drilled on said "Outside Lands...". Such an agreement, e "itled "Agreement and Batification", has been entered into y Grat Basins Lecroleum Company; Porter Sesnon, Barbara Sesnon Cartan and William T. Sesnon, Jr., as Tenants in Common; Santa Fe Drilling Company; G. R. Scott; J. W. Dart and R. G. Greene; the owners of oil-and-gas operating-rights under said "Cutside Lands". Great Basins have now made an application requesting the State's consent to the aforesaid "Agreement and Ratification".
