IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, THE COMMISSION ACCEPTS THE HIGHEST QUALIFIED BID, MADE BY PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, A DELAWARE CORPORATION, AND PAULEY PETROLEUM INC., A DELAWARE CORPORATION, ON SEPTEMBER 20, 1962, AND AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE AN OIL AND GAS LEASE TO THE AFORESAID BIZDERS FOR THE 4,250.14-ACRE PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERCED LANDS DESIGNATED AS W.O. 4490 (PARCEL 9A), IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AS DETAILED IN THE NOTICE OF INTENTION, W.O. 4490, PUBLISHED AUGUST 7 AND AUGUST 14, 1962. PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASE, TIDE AND SUEMERGED LANDS, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 4490 (PARCEL 9A), P.R.C. 2933.1.

On September 20, 1962, two bids were received in response to a published Notice of Intention of the State Lands Commission to enter into a lease for the extraction of oil and gas from 4,250.14 acres of tide and submerged lands, designated as W.O. 4490 (Parcel 9A), Santa Barbara County. This offer was authorized by the Commission on July 19, 1962 (Minute Item 4, page 8167).

All bids submitted were reviewed by the staff as to technical sufficiency and economic factors. The office of the Attorney General reviewed the highest bid, submitted by Phillips Fetroleum Company and Pauley Petroleum Inc., and determined:

- A. That the Commission has complied with the procedural requirements of law; and
- B. That the bid submitted conforms with:
 - 1. The bid requirements specified in the proposal of the Commission;
 - 2. The applicable provisions of law; and
 - 3. The rules and regulations of the Commission.

A summary tabulation of the bonus-payment offers received pursuant to the lease proposal is attached.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE FUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, THE COMMISSION ACCEPT THE HIGHEST QUALIFIED BID, MADE BY PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, A DELAWARE CORPORATION, AND PAULEY PETROLEUM INC., A DELAWARE CORPORATION, ON SEPTEMBER 20, 1962, AND AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICEP TO ISSUE AN OIL AND GAS LEASE TO THE AFORESAID BIDDERS FOR 2HE 4,250.14-ACRE PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS DESIGNATED AS W.O. 4490 (PARCEL 9A), IN SANYA BARBARA COUNTY, AS DETAILED IN THE NOTICE OF INTENTION, W.O. 4490, PUBLISHED AUGUST 7 AND AUGUST 14, 1962.
