APPLICATION FOR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF TOMALES BAY, MARIN COUNTY; TEACHERS BEACH ASSOCIATION - W.O. 320.306.

An application has been received from Teachers Beach Association for a recreational pier permit on tide and submerged lands of Tomales Bay, Marin County, pursuant to Section 6503 of the Public Resources Code Staff Coursel and the office of the Attorney General upon review of this application have concurred that such permit cannot be authorized pursuant to Section 6503 under the circumstances specified in the application. In similar past situations commercial leases were issued. This matter has been presented to the Commission at two previous meetings, and action deferred, once upon request of the office of the Attorney General and once at the applicant's request. Spon further review, requested by the applicant, Staff Counsel's and the Attorney General's position with regard to this matter is unchanged.
