PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASE, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, ORANGE COUNTY - W.O. 4710 (PARCEL 14).

On June 20, 1963, three bids were received in response to a published Notice of Intention of the State Lands Commission to enter into a lease for the extraction of oil and gas from 2,113 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands, designated as W.O. 4710 (Parcel 14), Orange County. This offer was authorized by the Commission on March 28, 1963 (Minute Item 17, pages 8752-53).


All bids submitted were reviewed by the staff as to technical sufficiency and economic factors. The office of the Attorney General reviewed the highest bid submitted by Union Oil Company of California, and determined:

- A. That the Commission has complied with the procedural requirements of law; and
- B. That the bid submitted conforms with:
  - 1. The bid requirements specified in the proposals of the Commission;
  - 2. The applicable provisions of law; and
  - 3. The rules and regulations of the Commission.

A summary tabulation of the bonus-payment offers received pursuant to the lease proposal is attached (Exhibit "A").
