On March 4, 1965, one bid was received in response to a published Notice of Intention of the State Lands Commission to enter into a lease for the extraction of oil and gas from approximately 4,290 acres of tide and submerged lands designated as W.O. 5424 (Parcel 24), Santa Barbara County. This offer was authorized by the Commission on December 17, 1564 (Minute Item 33, page 10,821).

The bid submitted was reviewed by the staff as to technical sufficiency and economic factors. The office of the Attorney General reviewed the bid submitted by Richfield Oil Corporation and Secony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., and determined:

- A. That the Commission has complied with the procedural requirements of law;
- B. That the bid submitted conforms with:
 - 1. The bid requirements as specified in the proposals of the Commission;
 - 2. The applicable provisions of law; and
 - 3. The rules and regulations of the Commission.

The cash-bonus payment offered in the rid by Richfield Oil Corporation and Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., was \$3,667,111.00.
