Installation of the cable was completed on October 1.0, 1968. The applicant has submitted an amended legal description to indicate the "as buill" location. The "as built" description reflects an additional. cable length of 687.88 feet, including a loop of some 250 feet within the 500-x 500 -foot area of Farcel B. The applicant reports that the cable was damaged during installation, makinfs i.t necessary to leave the loop to Ellow sufficient slack to raise and repair the cable. The annual rental requirement will be increased from $\$ 610.87$ to $\$ 633.23$ because of the added footage of 688 feet.
