WORK PERFORMED: Permittee has performed geological work and constructed access roads. Permittee drilled and completed well. "Ottoboni-State 3396" I on Prospecting Permit P.R.C. 3396.2. The well was tested for 200,000 pounds of steam per hour. The permittee proposes to drill another well on State land within the near future.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
The permits were issued on June 13, 1966, for a primary term of two years under Section 6891 of the Public Resources Code. The permittee applied for conversion of the permits under the Geothermal Resources Act of 1967, and the primary term of the permits was revised to three years in accordance with Section 6910 of the Act. Section 6910 also provides that any permit may be extended for a period not exceeding two years.
