MINUTE ITEM

17. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED EXPENDITURE OF TIDELAND OIL REVENUE FOR SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, CITY OF LONG BEACH, LOS ANGELES COUNTY - W 10279.

After consideration of Calendar Item 25 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION APPROVES COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK AS INDICATED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HEREBY MADE A PART HEREOF, FOR THE PERIOD JULY 26, 1971, TO JUNE 30, 1972; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS THAT THE AMOUNTS, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 4(d) OF CHAPTER 138, STATUTES OF 1964, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED, SAID REVIEW AND AUDIT TO CONSIDER SUBSIDENCE COSTS DISBURSED FOR WORK DEFINED ON JOB RECORDS AS TO LOCATION AND SUBSIDENCE CHARACTER; AND THAT THE WORK WILL CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION.

FURTHER, THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTION OF APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.

Subsidence Maintenance, 1971-72 F.Y.

SUBSIDENCE ELEMENTS:

a. City Presentation

The project consists of work required to remedy the damaging effects of subsidence in the Harbor District during the 1971-72 Fiscal Year.

b. Staff Analysis

Initial study concludes that some subsidence costs are included but not necessarily all those estimated by the City.
