After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION APPROVES COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK FOR SUBSIDENCE MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS TO TERMINAL FACILITIES, IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FOR THE PERIOD DECEMBER 21, 1971 TO JUNE 30, 1972; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS THAT THE AMOUNTS, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 4(d) OF CHAPTER 138, STATUTES OF 1964, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED, SAID REVIEW AND AUDIT TO CONSIDER SUBSIDENCE COSTS DISBURSED FOR WORK DEFINED ON JOB RECORDS AS TO LOCATION AND SUBSIDENCE CHARACTER; AND THAT THE WORK WILL CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION. FURTHER, THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTION OF APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.
