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QUITCLAIM OF OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 3601.1
SACRAMENTO AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTIES

LESSEE: Burmah Oil and Gas Company (formerly Signal Oil and Gas Company)

LOCATION: Tide and submerged lands underlying portions of the San Joaquin and False River, Sacramento and Contra Costa Counties.

ACREAGE: 600 acres more or less.

DATE ISSUED: September 26, 1966.

EXPIRATION DATE: September 25, 1986.

PREREQUISITE: A. The Lease Quitclaim Deed executed by the lessee dated September 25, 1975.
B. Compliance with terms and conditions of the Lease through September 26, 1975.

PERTINENT INFORMATION:
In February, 1968, Signal Oil and Gas Company (now Burmah Oil and Gas Company) drilled a well "State 3601", 1 from an onshore location into the State submerged lands. The well was abandoned on February 20, 1968. The lessee has also conducted extensive geophysical exploration operations in the area of the lease.
