APPROVAL OF DESCRIPTION AND MAPS
SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT

By Section 4, Chapter 67, Statutes of 1962, First Extraordinary Session, the California Legislature provided for the establishment of the San Diego Unified Port District.

Section 14 of that Act directs each of the Cities of San Diego, National City, Chula Vista and Coronado to convey to the San Diego Unified Port District, "all its right, title and interest in and to the tidelands and submerged lands, together with any facilities thereon, which are owned by the city, including any such lands which have been granted in trust to the city by the State in the Bay of San Diego"; certain tideland and submerged lands of the Cities of San Diego and Coronado excepted.

Section 87(6)(i) of Chapter 67, Statutes of 1962, provides that the State Lands Commission shall, at the cost of the district, survey and monument the transferred lands and record a description and plat thereof in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County.

A service agreement was executed between the State Lands Commission and the San Diego Unified Port District, providing for the payment of services rendered by the State. Pursuant to this agreement, the Division has surveyed, monumented, and prepared a description of the granted area. Both the Office of the Attorney General and the San Diego Unified Port District have reviewed the Division's work and finds the work acceptable.

Description and maps of the transferred lands have been completed.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. AUTHORIZE THE APPROVAL OF THE MAPS, IN 36 SHEETS, DATED OCTOBER, 1972, ENTITLED "MAP OF THE LANDS TRANSFERRED TO THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 67, STATUTES OF 1962, 1ST E.S., VICINITY OF SAN DIEGO BAY", PREPARED UNDER W 4443.
2. AUTHORIZE THE RECORDING, IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY, OF THE MAPS AND DESCRIPTION OF THE LANDS CONVEYED IN TRUST TO THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT.
