MAINTENANCE DREDGING OPERATION

APPLICANT: Santa Clara County Department
of Public Works
70 West Hedding Street
San Jose, California 95110

PROPOSED DREDGING: To perform maintenance dredging of 90,000
cubic yards within the water area, on tide
and submerged land (approximately 7 acres),
in the marina at Alviso, as described on
attached Exhibit "A", Santa Clara County.

SPOIL PLACEMENT: The sediments are to be removed by hydraulic
dredging and transported by means of a pipe-
line to a 23 acre disposal site behind dikes
on Santa Clara County Park lands located
adjacent to Guadalupe Slough and Calabazas
Creek.

PURPOSE: For continued operation of a public marina.

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit; no royalty required.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT CONSIDERATION:
1. An Environmental Impact Report is not
required. This project is within the
purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2910(a),
Class 4, which exempts a maintenance
dredging operation.
2. This project is situated on State land
identified as possessing significant
environmental values, pursuant to Public
Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified
in a significant use category, Class C:
Multiple Use. Staff review indicates
that there will be no significant effect
upon the identified environmental values.
The staff of the Division has received
no adverse comments on this project.

OTHER PERTINENT DATA:
1. The proposed dredge area was last dredged
in 1967 under the previous Dredging Permit
PRC 3606.
2. The sediments are to be removed by hydraulic
dredging.

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3. Waste Discharge Requirements, Order No. 76-13, governing both the dredging and wastewater overflow that will be discharged from the disposal area into Guadalupe Slough, were adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board on February 17, 1976.
4. The Department of Fish and Game, in responding to the Bay Conservation and Development Commission, had no objection to this project.
5. This permit will be issued contingent upon the applicant's securing a Corps of Engineers Permit and a Regional Water Quality Control Board Certificate of Conformance.
6. Effective period of the permit to be May 27, 1976, to December 31, 1976.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NEED NOT BE PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORTS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2910(a).
2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE APPLICATION WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON THE ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1 ET SEQ., OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.
3. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO DREDGE 90,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AT THE ALVISO MARINA, SAN JOSE, SUCH AREA BEING DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, AND TO SPOIL SUCH DREDGED MATERIAL ON COUNTY PARK UPLANDS, AT NO ROYALTY; PERMIT TO BE EFFECTIVE MAY 27, 1976 TO DECEMBER 31, 1976; SUCH PERMISSION TO BE SUBJECT TO THE ISSUANCE OF A CORPUS OF ENGINEERS PERMIT, A REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMANCE, AND TO ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS, RECOMMENDATIONS OR LIMITATIONS AS SET OR AS MAY BE SET BY STATE, FEDERAL OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the state owned bed of Steamboat and Alviso Sloughs, situate in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Southerly line of Steamboat Slough, said point of beginning being also the Easterly terminus of a course shown as S 72° 25' 30" E, 160.00 feet on that certain amended record of survey recorded July 18, 1963, in Book 163 of maps at Page 19, Santa Clara County Records; thence N 72° 25' 30" W, 160.00 feet, S 71° 26' 30" W, 55.00 feet, S 51° 26' 30" W, 195.00 feet, N 58° 34' 30" W, 125.00 feet, N 35° 14' 51" E, 265.53 feet, S 33° 25' 26" E, 112.27 feet, N 48° 54' 17" E, 105.63 feet, S 62° 30' 43" E, 280.00 feet; thence Southerly across Steamboat Slough S 14° 09' 20" W, 82.81 feet; thence N 54° 12' 54" W, 72.74 feet to the point of beginning.
