MAINTENANCE DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

State of California,
Department of Fish and Game
1416 - 9th Street
Sacramento, California 95814

PROPOSED DREDGING:

To perform, over a 10-year period, dredging
of approximately 16,000 cubic yards of material
per year (total material dredged to be approxi-
mately 160,000 cubic yards) on tide and submerged
lands from sloughs adjacent to Joyce and Grizzly
Islands, Solano County.

SPOILS PLACEMENT:

All spoils are to be deposited on Joyce and
Grizzly Islands for the purpose of continually
maintaining levees.

PURPOSE:

The levees and their maintenance are to provide
proper draining and flooding of portions of
the islands to lure and sustain waterfowl and
to maintain water surface elevations in rest-
in ponds.

CONSIDERATION:

The public benefit; no royalty.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT CONSIDERATION:

An Environmental Impact Report is not required.
This project is within the purview of Title 2,
Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 4, which exempts a
maintenance dredging operation.

OTHER PERTINENT DATA:

1. Silt and sand are to be removed by a barge-
mounted clamshell dredge.
2. Permits were secured from the following
agencies:
 - A. San Francisco Bay Conservation and
Development Commission Permit No. M-76-22.
 - B. U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service letter
of "no objection" dated March 31, 1976.
 - C. Regional Water Quality Control Board
letter of "no objection" dated May 13, 1976.
3. Effective period of the permit shall be from
June 24, 1976 through December 31, 1980.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS MAINTENANCE DREDGING PROJECT AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER PROVISIONS OF TITLE 2, CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.
2. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO DREDGE 160,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL (15,000 CUBIC YARDS ANNUALLY FOR 10 YEARS) FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AT JOYCE AND GRIZZLY ISLANDS, SOLANO COUNTY, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; AT NO ROYALTY, THE CONSIDERATION BEING THE PUBLIC BENEFIT. THE PERMIT WILL BE EFFECTIVE FROM JUNE 24, 1976 TO DECEMBER 31, 1986; SUCH PERMISSION TO BE SUBJECT TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND/OR APPROVALS OF ALL CONCERNED AGENCIES, AND TO ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS, RECOMMENDATIONS OR LIMITATIONS AS SET OR AS MAY BE SET BY STATE, FEDERAL OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

Twenty-six parcels of tide and submerged land in the State owned beds of Roaring River Slough, Montezuma Slough, Suisun Slough and Volanti Slough, Solano County, California, further described as follows and shown on Exhibits "A-1" through "A-5":

EXHIBIT "A-1" and "A-2"

Those sites numbered 1 through 17 bordering upon Joice Island within the beds of Suisun, Montezuma and Volanti Sloughs.

EXHIBIT "A-3"

Those sites numbered 18 through 23 adjacent to Grizzly Island within the bed of Montezuma Slough.

EXHIBIT "A-4"

Portion of site number 25 adjacent to Hammond Island within the bed of Roaring River Slough; and Site 24 within the bed of Montezuma Slough.

EXHIBIT "A-5"

Sites numbered 25 and 26 adjacent to Hammond Island within the bed of Roaring River Slough.
