16. PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT - United States Navy - W 503.628.

During consideration of Galendar Item 16, attached, Assemblyman Dan Boatright, 10th District appeared, stating that the matter was actually two fold. The first being the problem with the right to exect a barrier. If a person is trespassing on the land they cannot be cited for trespassing. The Navy would like to close off the land to the public for security reasons.

Mr. James F. Trout, Manager, Land Operations, then read the provisions of the lease. It was then moved and seconded for the adoption of the amended lease. Assemblyman Boatright then brought up the one-year lease. It originally was a 49-year lease and felt coming back every year was unnecessary. Chairman Kenneth Gory asked if there was a cancellation clause in the lease. Mr. Robert C. Hight, Staff Counsel, replied it may be cancelled by either party in 30 days. Chairman Cory said a 10-year lease would seem in order.

Captain Joe Paulis, Commanding Officer of the Naval Weapons Station, appeared. He briefly explained about the people who enter into the area, not realizing the danger of carrying rifles with all the high explosives around.

At this time it was moved and second the adoption of a 10-year lease with a 30 day cancellation provision. Captain Paulis noted that the adoption would exclude people from trespassing in the area. Mr. N. Gregory Taylor, Assistant Attorney General, briefly explained the rights of the people and the jurisdiction of the land in question.

Upon motion duly made and carried, Calendar Dtem 16 was adopted with the following amendments:

4. THE LESSEE SHALL HAVE ALL RIGHTS OF THE LLASEMOLDER TO HAVE QUIET POSSESSION AND USE OF THE PROPERTY: THE LEASE WILL PROVIDE FOR 30 DAYS CANCELLATION OF TERMS BY EITHER PARTY.

- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use entegory, Class A.

Staff has determined that the restriction of public access Will not adversely impact the identified values.

Inasmuch as the lease is to close off the area from public use, all environmental area from public use, art environmentar values will be protected. It is detervalues will be brotected. It is determined that the lease will have no significant environmental effects.

During the 1974-1975 condemnation proceedings involving the weapon station site, Hastings Slough was specifically negotiated out of the settlement because of the public traist and public use.
