AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS IN 2 CAL. ADM. CODE
ARTICLE 10, REGARDING EVALUATION OF PROJECTS
AND PROCESSING OF ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTS

Recently, major changes to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) were signed into law by the Governor. One of the amendments provides for detailing only the significant effects which may accrue to a project. Consequently, the Secretary for Resources on September 30, 1976, promulgated amendments to the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of these new provisions.

The Division has analyzed the changes to State EIR Guidelines as to their effect on the Commission's implementing regulations. Numerous changes and additions thereto have been found desirable. The proposed Article 10 completely replaces the old Article 10. They are shown in Exhibit "A", on file in the office of the State Lands Commission and by reference made a part hereof.

EXHIBIT: A. Proposed Changes to California Administrative Code, Title 2, Division 3, Article 10.
