AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOGATION:

A 0.011-acro parcel of tide and submerged land in the San Joaquin River adjacent to Jersey Island, Contra Costa County.

LAND USE:

A water quality surveillance station,

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: Ten (10) years, from January 8, 1976.

Renewal options: One successive period of ten (10) years.

CONSILLERATION:

The public use and benefit with State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Compission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES;

Applicant is permittee of upland. Application received prior to Administrative Gode processing cost arendment.

STATUTORY AND LAMER REFERENCES:

A. Fublic Resources Code: Div. 6, Farts 1 and 2.

B. Administrative Code: Thtle 2, Div. 7, Arts. 1, 2. 10 and 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 7. This is a replacement for a provious eight-year permit expiring January 7, 1976.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 5. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 3 Cal. Adm. Code 2907 (a) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

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". This project is situated on State land identified us passessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1. and is classified in a use category, Class B which suthorizes limited use.

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Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

A parcel of tide and submerred land 20 feet wide in the bed of the San Joaquin River adjacent to I rsy Island, Contra Costa County, California, lying 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

CONMENCING at C. & G.S. triangulation station "Hume 1931" having California Zone II coordinates of Y= 136,895.72 and Z= 2,080,574.10, thence S G 00' E, 3,550 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, thence N 6' 00' R, 50 feet to the terminous of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying Landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Can Joaquin River.

Bearings, distances and coordinates in the above description are based upon the California Coordinate System, Sone II.
