AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATIONS

0.83 acres (PRC 3972.1) and 0.50 acres (PRC 3973.1) of tide and submerged lands in the beds of Mallard Slough and Coyote

Creck, Santa Clara County.

LAND USE:

Salt brine papeline rights of way.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 25 years from May 26, 1952.

Renewal options: 2 successive periods of 10

years each.

Consideration:

\$103.32 (PRC 3972.1) and \$63 (PRC 3973.1) per annum.

TERMS OF LEASES DURING ENSUINC RENEWAL PERIOD:

Initial period: 10 years from May 26, 1977.

Renewal options: 1 successive period of 10 years each.

Consideration:

\$158.40 (PRC 3972.1), \$137.97 (PRC 3973.1) per annum; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

1 1/2 cents per diameter inch of pipeline or conduit, per lineal foot.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is owner of upland.

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline crosion or other types of environmental degradation.
- 2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class "B" which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

Two pancels of tide and submerged land in the bed of Coyote Slough, Alameda and Senta Clark Counties, California, said parcels more particularly described as follows:

### PARCEL 2

COMMENCING at a concrete monument (Neslie Salt Monument 91) described as bearing 11 800 341 E and distant 879.5 feet from the querter Section corner common to Sections 28 and 33, TSS, RIV. 1004. in that certain Quiet Title Suit No. 114, 249, recorded in Volume 2860 at page 1 of the Official Records of the County of Alameda, and proceeding thence : 880 23, 48" E, 3486,8 feet to a point on the south bank of Covote Slough, said point being hereinafter referred to as point "B"; thence leaving Foint "B" and crossing a portion of Coyote Slough il 590 034 52" E, 456.0 feet to a point on the perimeter of an island in said slowth; thence along the perimeter of said island the following five courses and distances: N 770 19' 11" E, 246.0 feet; S Sho 50' 58" E, 201.8 feet; and \$ 81° co. 54. E. 144.14 foet to the POINT of BECINNING of the percel herein described; thence crossing the remainder of Coyote Slough H 120 30' 37" E, 131,27 feet to a point on the north back of said slough; thence slong the borth bank 5 770 05' 27" E, 100,00 feet; thence arein crossing a portion of Coyote C 12º 30" 37" W. 12h.38 feet to a point on the island in said slough ; thouse N 81° 00' 27" W, 100,18 feet to the point of beginning.

above and proceeding across a portion of Coyete Slouph N 50° 03' 52" E.
h56.0 feet to a point on the peripoter of an island in said slough;
thence along the peripoter of said island 6 77° 32' 3h" E.
h51.5 feet; and 8 70° 38! 27" E. 92.80 feet to the POINT OF
BEGINNING of the parcel herein described; thence continuing
along the terimeter of said island 8 70° 38' 27" E. 1.70 feet;
and 8 61° h0' 10" E. 102.17 feet; thence crossing a portion of
Coyote Slough 3 10° 30' 37" M. 203.50 feet to a point on the
south bank of said slough; thence along the south bank the
foct; 8 85° 17' 55" W. 60.60 feet; and 8 80° 01' 20" W. 1.32
feet; thence again crossing a portion of Coyote Slough N 12° 36' 37" E.

All bearings in the above described parcels except the record bearing (# 89° 34° E) described in Parcel 1 are based on the California Zone 3 Coordinate System.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Coyote Slough.
