PERTINENT INFORMATION:

State Grothermal Resources Lease PRC 4597 was issued to Union Oil Company on May 27, 1971. Or April 27, 1972, an undivided 25% interest in the lease was assigned to Magma P wer Company and an undivided 25% interest was assigned to Termal Power Company. Pursuant to the terms of the lease, Union has requested approval of the State Lands Commission to drill wells "IF State 4597" 25, 26 and 27. The wells will be drilled from a single drillsite that has been inspected and approved by Division staff. The proposed drilling and completion programs have been reviewed by the staff and determined to be a accordance with good engineering pract.ces and the rules and regulations of the Commission.

The wells will be used to furnish steam to electrical generating Unit No. 12. The unit is under construction and should be operational in July of 1978. Approximately 50% of the steam used in this unit will be supplied by State wells. Royalty income from the Unit will be about \$400,000 per year.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT.

The Schoma County Board of Zoning Adjustments, acting as lead agency, prepared and circulated an environmental impact maport covering Union cil Company's geothermal lease-hold operations.

By Notice of Determination issued on October 4, 1976, the Sonoma County Board of Zoning Adjustments certified that (1) the Environmental Impact Report was prepared pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended; (2) the project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and (3) the project has been approved by the Sonoma County Board of Zoning Adjustments. The Notice of Determination has been filed with the State Secretary for Researces, the State Lands Division, and the County Clerk for Sonoma County, wherein the project is to be undertaken.

State agencies concerned with geothermal operations were notified that the staff intended to recommend approval of these wells. None of the agencies responded to the notice.
