PROPOSED EXPENDITURE OF TIDELAND OIL REVENUE FOR SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK CITY OF LONG BEACH

SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL PROJECT:
Subsidence Maintenance, 1977-78 Fiscal Year.

SUBSIDENCE ELEMENTS:

- A. City's Presentation: Maintenance Work is needed in the 1977-78 Fiscal Year to repair subsidence damage to harbor district facilities.
- B. Staff Analysis: Some subsidence maintenance costs are appropriate but not necessarily to the extent estimated by the City.

COST OF PROJECT:

- A. City's Estimate: \$50,000 for specific categories plus \$45,000 for con ingencies.
- F. Staff Analysis: Estimate is in line with historically recent expenditures.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Costs borne 100% by State.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY;

- A. City's Reference: Chapter 138/64, 1st E. S.
- B. Staff Determination: Chapter 138/64, 1st E.S., Sec. 1 (e)

DISCUSSION:

Details of the proposed work are set forth in a letter from the Port of Long Beach Assistant General Manager, dated May 23, 1977.

The amounts requested are considered minimal to cover work for which approval is intended, should the need for such work arise.

Beginning in 1972, a Subsidence Maintenance Contingency Fund was authorized each year to provide for unforeseen costs. A \$45,000 Contingency Fund is recommended for the duration of the 1977-78 Fiscal Year to dover possible costs to be expended by the City in addition to or over and above the estimated amounts recommended for specific categories. Contingency Fund expenditures are limited to emergency type circumstances where time does not permit processing a request for Commission prior approval of needed additional funds for urgent subsidence remedial or protective work.

If the use of the Contingency Fund becomes necessary, the City will formally notify the Division's Executive Officer or Manager, Long Beach Operations prior to any expenditure with adequate detailed explanation of the work proposed. The final amount of subsidence costs allowed, if any, will be determined by the Commission after an engineering review and audit when the work is completed.

APPROVE COSTS PROPOSET TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SURSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS INDICATED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY J, 1977 TO JUNE 30, 1978, SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSIONS THAT THE AMOUNTS, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 4 (d) OF CHAPTEL 138/64, 1st E.S., WILL BU DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UP AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSTOMENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED, SAID REVIEW AND AUDIT TO CONSIDER SUBSIDENCE COSTS DISBURSED FOR WORK DEFINED ON JOB RECORDS AS TO LOCATION AND SUBSIDENCE CHARACTER AND THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLAYS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL FREYTOUSLY SURMITTED TO THE COMMISSION.
