EXTENSION OF BAIR ISLAND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY AGREEMENT

An Environmental Study Agreement, P.R.C. 4894, executed December 2, 1973, between Mobil Oil Estates (Bair Island Investments) Limited and the State, called for the State, the City of Redwood City, and others, to determine the environmental qualities of Bair Island and the compatible uses thereof. At the conclusion of the study and within three years and seven months, Mobil was to grant at least 60 acres of ecologically sensitive Tand to the State.

At the request of the City of Redwood City and the County of San Mateo, Mobil and the State have been requested to extend the terms of the study agreement for a period of three months, from July 3, 1977 to October 3, 1977, to allow discussion between Redwood City and the County, on implementing the terms of said agreement with the State.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION GRANT AN EXTENSION OF THE BAIR ISLAND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY AGREEMENT (P.R.C. 4894) FROM JULY 3, 1977 TO AND INCLUDING OCTOBER 3, 1977.
