An 0.149 acre parcel of submerged land at

LAND USE:

For maintenance can existing multiple use

public recreation pier.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMET:

initial period: 49 years from January 1, 1975.

Public liability insurance: \$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and \$50,000 for property damage.

Special: 1. The permit is conditioned on permitteeks conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.

- 2. Permittee agrees to give notice that the State Lands Commission has contributed a portion of the land utilized by the pier.
- 3. Paragraph 2 of Section 5, entitled "Monetary Consideration" is deleted.

The public use and benefit. CONSIDERATION:

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of the upland:

As this transaction was in a negotiation status prior to June 30, 1975, there are no applicable processing costs.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers approved the initial structure in 1952. The staff has received no negative comments relative to its existence from any other agency. TRPA has not yet considered the facility.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$274.40.

- This structure is situated immediately southerly of the Department of Parks & Recreation's Kings Beach State Recreation area and immediately westerly of the Department of Navigation and Ocean Development's Boat Launching Ramp Project which are each free public day use recreational facilities. The existing pier serves to complement the recreational use of the littoral area.
 - 3. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1B, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
 - This project is situated on State land. identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 0370, 1, and is classified in a use category, Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
