AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An 0.174-acre parcel of submerged land in the Russian River hear Guerneville, Sonoma County.

LAND USE:

Wastewater force main crossings and outfall structure.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE.

ED LEASE: Initial period: 49 years from August 1, 1977.

CONSIDERATION: The public Health and safety with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the commission finds such action to be in the state's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is permittee of upland

processing costs have been received.

Two strips of land, 20 feet wide, in the bed of the Russian River, Sonoma Comity, Galifornia, said strips being 10 feet on each side of the following described centerlines:

#### PARCEL A

BEGINITIG at the intersection of the southwesterly edge of a paved area, on the north easterly side of the Russian River, and a 16 inch Ecrop Main pipe, said intersection being located 1,200 feet, more or less, southerly of Vacation Reach; thence from said point of beginning, southwesterly and washerly, along said force main, 300 feet to the and of the herein described centerling.

#### PARCEL B

BEGINNING at the intersection of the northerly edge of the Guerneville Highway (New 12) and the westerly of two = 10 inch Force Pain pipes, said intersection being located at the northwesterly edge of Northwood Heights as shown on the 1954 edition of the 7.5 minute CAMP MEEKER, CALIF, quadrangle map; thence from said point of beginning northerly along said 10 inch force main, 450 feet to the end of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of the abovedescribed parcels lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Russion River.
