A strip of tide and submersed land, 20 feet wide, in the bed of Hill Slough, County of Solano, California, strunted in protracted Section 6, Tan, R2W, 1901, said strip being 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

BEGINNING at a point in the right-of-way for Grigzly Island Road (Solano County Road No. 578), 50.00 feet wide, said point being \$ 80° 15' w 8,00 feet from the centerline of said Grizziv Island Road at the Northerly end of the bridge over Hill Slough, thence S 9° 45 E, parallel with said centerline and along the Westerly edge of said bridge, 189 feet, more or less, to the Southerly end of said bridge.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any postion lying landward of the ordinary high water marks of little Slough.
