AREA; TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An approximate one acre partially tidal berm having 9,000 square feet of use area in the Sacramento Riven adjačent to Grand Island, Sachamento County

LAND USE:

For the continued use of a berm improved with an existing cabin and outbuilding.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMITS

Initial period: 10 years from June 1, 1977.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

Public liability insurance: \$100,000 as a single limit for hodily injury and property damage,

Special:

Existing structures shall not be used as a permanent residence.

CONSIDERATION: \$170 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

General Permit rental pursuant to 2 cal. Adm. iCode 2006.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Filing fee has been received.

structures until very recently. owners of the improvements apparently did not know of the requirement that such structures required State Dands Commission authorization. Present owners of these structures have been very cooperative in making application for appropriate permits

- Ar Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 cal. Adm. code 2907 (a), Class In. which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
 - mis project is situated on State land ldentified as possessing significant environmental values quisuant to Public Resources code 6370.4, and ils classified in a use category, class a which authorizes limited use.
