OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Environmental Impact Reports are not required in that these are existing facilities that are in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation, or the proposed facility involves construction of a small structure for one owner.

Authority: Administrative Gode, Title 2, Div. 3, Art. 10, Section 2907, Class 1 and 3.

The individual projects are situated on State land identified as possessing significan't environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and are classified in the use dategories B and C, which authorize limited and multiple use, or are situated on other lands identified as possessing environmental values as stated in the December 1, 1975 State Lands Commission meeting. Article 10, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Classes 1 and 3 exempt existing facilities exempt existing facilities and new construction of small structures from the EIR requirements of CEQA. However, staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

- 3. WP 3576 and WP 3567; recreation piers in Huntington Marbour have been found to pose no significant adverse environmental effects (cumulative EIR by City). - 4. W 21223; a recreational pler in Tomales Bay, has been found to pose no significant adverse environmental effects and the area has been found able to accommodate the development. Accordingly, it is exempt from Article 6.5 of Title 2, of the California Administrative Code.
- 5. W 21279 will require a permit from the Corps of Engineers.
