MARINA SITE AND DREDGING PERMIT PRC 5361

APPLICANT:

Carl Bennett Rodeo Marina 13 Pacific Avenue Rodeo, California 94572

PROPOSED DREDGING:

To perform, over a lo-year period, maintenance dredging of an approximate yearly total not to exceed 10,000 cubic yards of material from an area of tide and submerged lands adjacent to San Pablo Bay, Contra-Costa County.

SPOILS PLACEMENT:

The dredging would be accomplished by hydraulic dredge, and the dredged material would be pumped onto a barge. The material would be transported and disposed of at San Francisco Disposal Site 9 in the Carquinez Strait.

OWNERSHIP:

The area involves disputed titles. The final determination of titles and boundaries may take substantial time to complete. Mr. Bennett has indicated that further delay will force his marina out of business. Therefore, a no-prejudice permit is proposed during the interim. Mr. Bennett's lessor, A. F. Bray, has joined in the request for the no-prejudice permit. Future settlement of titles, rental, and royalty would be submitted to the Commission for its review. The no-prejudice permit will cover both the marina and the maintenance dredging.

CONSIDERATION:

Upon resolution of the title and boundaries questions, the applicant shall be responsible retroactively for any rental or royalties due for the term covered by this permit for portions that may extend upon sovereign fee owned lands. Such rental would be at the normal rate for the time period in question that has been established by the Commission. Royalties would be due at the rate of \$0.15 per cubic yard.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

- 1. An environmental Impact Report is not required. This project is within the purview of 2 car. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1, which exempts existing facilities.
- 2. This project is situated on State land identified as multiple use area, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 6370.1, and is classified use category, Class C. Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon identified environmental values, upon identified environmental values, in fact, applicant has changed method of disposal in conformance with request from the Resources Agency.

OTHER PERTINENT DATE:

- 1. Applicant has requested permission and has received permits to perform the dredging from the following agencies:
 - à. San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission Permit \$77-44 issued July 1, 1977;
 - b. San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board Certificate \$77-13 issued July 5, 1977.
- 2. Applicant has pending request for a permit with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers PN 10966-52. State Lands is the last agency from which a permit is required before the Corps will issue its permit.
- 3. Effective period of the permit is to be July 26, 1977 to July 25, 1987.

AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A NO-PREJUDICE PERMIT TO CARL BENNETT FOR MARINA PURPOSES, AND TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE DREDGING NOT TO EXCEED 10,000 CUBIC YARDS PER YEAR, OVER A 10-YEAR PERIOD, FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS ADJACENT TO SAN PABLO BAY, SUCH AREA BEING DESCRIBED IN EXHLET "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; RENTAL AND ROYALTY SHALL BE DUE FOR ANY PORTION THAT MAY EXTEND UFON SOVEREIGN FEE OWNED LANDS; SUCH RENTAL WILL BE AT THE STANDARD RATE ESTABLISHED FOR THE TIME PERIOD IN QUESTION; ROYALTY, IF ANY, SHALL BE CHARGED AT THE RATE OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE JULY 26, 1977 THROUGH JULY 25, 1987.

Beginning at a point on the northern boundary line of the right of way boundary line of the parcel of land described in the deed to Pacific Patent Plaster Company, recorded September 25, 1890, Book 59, Deeds, page 58, intersects the said right of way, said point being the most easterly corner of along the northern boundary line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Patent Plaster Company's tract (59 h 58); thence North 690 304 East Railroad Company, 644 5 feet to station; thence North 130 15 East 900 feet more or less to station; thence North 610 15 West 590 feet more or less to South 410 36 West 1,420 feet more or less to station; thence South 610 10 East along the northeast boundary line of said Pacific Patent Plaster Company's tract (59 h 58), 728 feet into the point of beginning.
