GENERAL RERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

Sacramento Regional County

Sanitation District 827 Seventh Street

Sacramento, California

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 815 x 100 (1.87 acre) parcel of inland non-tidal navigable submerged land in the bed of the American River, City of Sacramento,

Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Construct and maintain three 48" diameter pipelines for the transport of wastewater across the American River.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT!

Initial period: 49 years from September 1, 1977:

CONSIDERATION:

The public health and safety with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2. Α.

Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$800.

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- 2. The City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento as a joint venture are constructing various facilities throughout the County as part of a program necessary to meet present and future water quality standards. All of these facilities are covered in the "Sacramento Regional Wastewater Management Program". Major facilities have also been treated in accordance with GEOA in separate environmental impact reports.
- The portion of the overall project covered by the proposed permit has been treated in an Environmental Impact Report entitled "Northeast Interception System" circulated through the State Clearinghouse as SCH #75122950.
- 4. A final environmental impact report was prepared by the County of Sacramento, pursuant to GEQA and implementing regulations. A Notice of Determination has been received:
- 5. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use Class A which authorizes Restricted Use.

Starf has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.
