AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.689 acre parcol of submerged land in the bed of the Tuolumne River near the town of La Grange, Spanislaus County.

LAND USE:

Construction and maintenance of a concrete bridge for a county road.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49 years, from April 1, 1977.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

Processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

Fublic Resources Code, Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100. A negative declaration was prepared by the County of Stanislaus, pursuant to CEQA and

2. This project is situated State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is plassified in a use category, Olass B which authorizes Limited Use.
