GENERAL LEASE COMMERCIAL USE

APPLICANT:

James C. and Myra B. Cranley Route 1, Box 144
Glenn, California 95943

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An 0.362 acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River near Glenn, Glenn

LAND USE:

Maintenance of a small boat marina.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years from September 1, 1973.

Renewal options: 3 successive periods of 10 years each.

Insurance: Combined single limit of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$225 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$225 minimum rental for this type of lease.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to snow injury to adjacent property, shorelline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- 2. This project is situated on State Land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1; and is classified in a use category. Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
