CANCELLATION OF USE PERMIT P.R.G. 5022.1; ISSUANCE OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANTS:

Donald Sweet, Sara Sweet, George S. Avanesslan, Patricia Avanessian, Joseph E. Venosa apa Joy Neomi 'Venosa 9 Sutter Street, Room 901 94104 San Francisco, CA

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATIONS

An 0,068-acre parcel and two 0.029-acre circular parcels, each 40 feet in diameter, all on submerged lands in Lake Tahoe at Kings Beach, Placer County.

LAND USE:

Construction of 1 pier, placement and mainten-ance of 1 new buoy and maintenance of 1 existing buoys respectively, for recreational boatung.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT FOR ONE BUOY:

5 years from July 1, 1975. Initial period:

Surety bond; \$500

Consideration:

\$100 per annum.

TERMS OF EROPOSED PERMIT:

unitial period: 10 years from July 1, 1977.

Public liability insurance: \$300,000 per occurrence for bodily

injury and \$50,000 for

property damage.

Special:

1. The permit is conditioned un permittee's conformance with the Tahoe Regional Flanning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.

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- 2. The permit is conditioned on the County of Placer's authorization and consent of any of the subject facilities found to se on or adjacent to County lands.
- 3. The permit is entered into by all parties without prejudice to their respective claims of boundary.

CONSIDERATION:

\$102.33 from July 1, 1977 through June 30, 1978; and \$110 per annum thereafter, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

2 Cal. Adm. Code 2006.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicants are the owner and permittees of the upland.

Filing fee and environmental costs have been received.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBLAINED:

This project is subject to the jurisdiction of the Tahoe Regional Training Agency's, U. S. Army, Corps of Engineers, California Department of tish and Game, Lahontan Regional Water Quality Swattol Board, and the County of Placer. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The issuance of Use Permit, PRC 5022.1 to Donald and Sara Sweet for placement of 1 Suoy was authorized by the Commission C. June 23, 1975 (Minute Item No. 14, page 645). Applicants, pursuant to an agreement dated October 25, 1976, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Commissic and by reference made a part hereof, now desire to construct a pier, and to place a second buoy, for their future enjoyment of a greater recreational benefit adjacent to their littoral land. Staff has been specifically requested to cancel the Use Permit and to incorporate the previously authorized buoy with the proposed facilities of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2006 effective March 1, 1977.

- An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1(B) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline existing or other types of environmental degradation; and Class (A) and (C) which exempts new construction of small structures.
- 3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 63/0.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.
