AUTHORIZATION FOR SUIT FOR EJECTMENT AND COLLECTION OF BACK RENTALS

APPLICANT:

Roy Rook Terwer Traller Park Star Route, Box 260 Klamath, California 95548

TYPE AND LOGATION:

A parcel of submerged land in the Klamath River near Klamath Glen, Del Norte County.

LAND USE:

Trespass

BACKGROUND:

The Division received State of California Resources Agency, Department of Fish and Game, notification of removal of materials and/or alteration of lake, river, or streambed bottom, or margin, notification No. 1033, dated June 16, 1976, relative to placement of docks in the Klamath River.

After review by the Division's title and engineering units, existing work order W 287.77, opened in 1967, was found to be identical to the proposed work described in the application to Department of Fish and Game.

Therefore, on August 18, 1976, Mr. Roy Rook was advised that it would be necessary for him to secure a lease from the State Lands Commission.

By letters, dated October 8, 1976, January 14, 1977, and August 9, 1977, Mr. Rook was advised that erection or maintenance of structures on State-owned land under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission without written authorization is in violation of the Public Resources Code.
