5.380+ lineal feet of right-of-way in the bed of Carquinez Strait, Solano and Contra

Costa Counties.

LAND USE:

Right-of-Way for petroleum pipelines (6"

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years from August 21,

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This activity is exempt from CEOA because it is not a project within the meaning of CEOA and the State EIR Guidelines.

Authority: P.R.C. 21065; 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15060.

2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

3. At its meeting on January 27, 1978, the Commission authorized the consolidation of all Southern Pacific Pipe Line Company (SPPL) leases into one master lease agreement. The consolidation lease included 3 SPPL pipelines formerly covered under the subject lease with Exxon Pipe Line Company. Staff is now recommending that SPPL be deleted as a joint lessee under the lease; that Exxon remain as sole lessee under the lease and that the rental be revised in accordance with the lease provisions and the Commission's rules and regulations.

In considering the rental revision staff analyzed the applicability of the volumetric rental alternative. Inasmuch as Exxon has not used the existing pipelines for over 1.5 years

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and current projections show that the refinery will utilize Alaskan crude oil exclusively, staff believes that the volumetric rental alternative is not appropriate at this time.

#### LAND DESCRIPTION

A strip of tide and submarged land 50 feet wide in Carquine. Strait, approximately 250 feet easterly of the Southern Pacific Railroad bridge between the City of Martinez, Contra Costa County and the City of Benicia, Solano County, California, said strip lying 25 fee on each side of the following described centerline:

BEGINNING at a point having coordinates X = 1,966.575.23and Y = 134,084.18; from which point United States Coast & Geodetic Survey triangulation station "Suisun Point 2" bears N 38° F4' 02" W, 74.62 feet; thence from said POINT OF BEGINNING N 29° 05' 28" W, 5379.03 feet more or less to the intersection with the easterly line of that Legislative Grant to the City of Benicia, Solano County, as described in Chapter 2018, Statutes of 1965, as Amended, said intersection point having coordinates X = 1.963,959.95, Y = 138,784.63 from which point United States Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station "Army Point 2" bears N 47° 42' 49" W, 1570.05 feet.

Bearings, distances and coordinates in the abov. description are based on the "California Coordinate System, Zone II".

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the southerly bank of Carquinez Strait.
